Disruption of presentations at any event organized by SDBP is strictly prohibited. Participants should not copy or take screen shots of Q&A or any chat room activity that takes place in the virtual space. Presentations, postings, and messages should not contain promotional materials, special offers, job offers, product announcements, or solicitation for services. SDBP reserves the right to remove any presentation, posting, or message that it deems to be inappropriate for a scientific meeting.
